
## Southern California Leadership Council Protecting Our Future



"To Ensure the Region's Economic Vitality and Quality of Life"


•Southern California's future depends upon a thriving economy and an unmatched quality of life for all who live here.




- •In the next 20 years, we will add 5 million more people to the region mostly from internal growth.

- •International trade (goods movement) volumes are expected to triple to and through Southern California.




•Because of our location and the size of our market, the volumes of goods moving to and from Asia and the U.S. will move to and through our region.

- 2.7 million more cars will make getting around on the freeways even more difficult.

- •We need to plan and build for this growth or both our quality of life and economic well being are threatened.




•The impact on our air quality and congestion from the massive movements of people and goods in the region need to be addressed or we risk public health and safety problems.




## The good news? There are solutions:


- •Every container moved by rail is a truck off our highways millions of truck trips can be eliminated.

- •And we can reduce congestion and pollution by eliminating bottlenecks in our highway and rail systems.




•We can create adequate, efficient new highway and rail capacity by building "Green Transportation Corridors."
