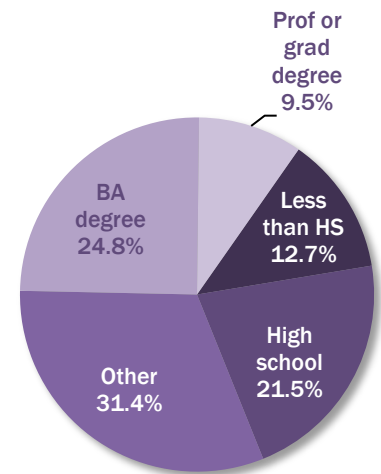

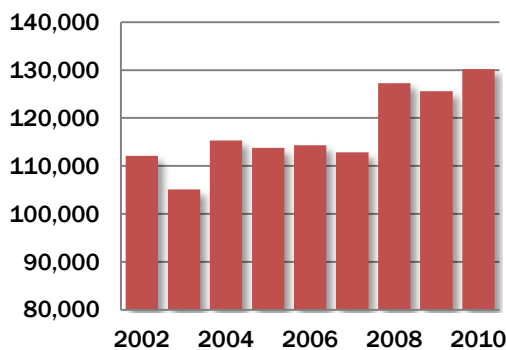

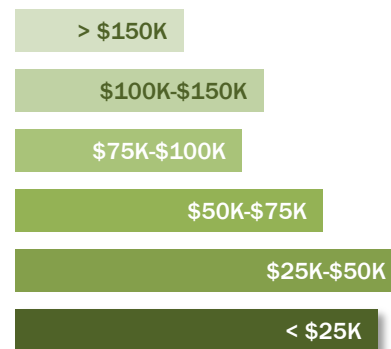
## Educational Achievement of Residents

## Household Income Distribution



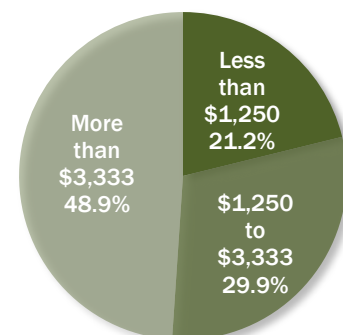
